COMES NOW Applicant and respectfully alleges and states as follows.

## 1. Parties

- a. The applicant, Sun Gas Company, A Division of Sun Oil Company (Delaware), Three NorthPark East, Box 20, Dallas, Texas 75221, is the owner of oil and gas leases or the right to drill in the area involved herein.
- b. There are no known respondents at this time, but notice is being given to those persons shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

## 2. Allegation of Facts:

- a. That heretofore, on the 1st day of April, 1966, the Commission entered its Order No. 62086, amending and extending initial spacing Order No. 61184 dated January 4, 1966, designating the captioned land as a single 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of hydrocarbons from the Tonkawa Sand, separate common source of supply, designating one well per 640-acre drilling and spacing unit. Subsequent to the issuance of said Order, a well was drilled to and completed in the Tonkawa Sand, separate common source of supply, in the NW/4 of Section 34. However, due to a substantial change of knowledge of reservoir conditions regarding the Tonkawa Sand formation as compared to conditions as known when such well pattern and density were first ordered, Applicant is now of the opinion that such ordered density is inadequate, and that to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights of the parties in the reservoir, an additional well on said unit is necessary to effectuate the maximum recovery of hydrocarbons from said common source of supply.
- b. That the drilling and spacing unit established by said Order listed in paragraph 2a above is a "proration unit" as defined by Section 2(8) of the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978.
- c. That said additional well requested by Applicant is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the common source of supply (reservoir) covered by the drilling and spacing unit established by said Order which cannot be effectively and efficiently drained by any existing well within said drilling and spacing unit.

- regal Authority: little 52, U.S.A. 1971, and 87.1 et. seq. and the general rules of the Commission.
- Relief Sought: Applicant requests that Order No. 61184 be amended to authorize the drilling of an additional well on the unit comprised of all of Section 34, Township 17 North, Range 22 West, Roger Mills County, Oklahoma, at a legal location, to test the Tonkawa Sand common source of supply.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that, after notice and hearing as required by law, the order amending said Order authorizing the drilling of an additional well on the above described unit be issued.
