Instructions for Recipient

If you are an individual, report the taxable amounts shown on this form on your tax return, as explained below. (Others, such as fiduciaries or partnerships, report the amounts on the corresponding lines of your tax return.)

Box 1 and 2—Report rents from real estate on Schedule E (Form 1040). If you provided significant services to the tenant, sold real estate as a business, or rented personal property as a business, report on Schedule C or C-EZ (Form 1040). For royalties on timber, coal, and iron ore, see Pub. 544, Sales and Other Dispositions of Assets.

Box 3—Report on the line for "Other income" on Form 1040 and identify the payment. If it is trade or business income, report this amount on Schedule C, C-EZ, or F (Form 1040). The amount shown may be payments you received as the beneficiary of a deceased employee, prizes, awards, taxable damages, or other taxable income.

Box 4—Shows backup withholding. For example, persons not furnishing their taxpayer identification number to the payer become subject to backup withholding at a 31% rate on certain payments. See Form W-9, Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification, for information on backup withholding. Include this on your income tax return as tax withheld.

Box 5—An amount in this box means the fishing boat operator considers you self-employed. Report this amount on Schedule C or C-EZ (Form 1040). See Publication 595, Tax Highlights for Commercial Fishermen.

Box 6—Report on Schedule C or C-EZ (Form 1040).

Box 7—Generally, payments for services reported in this box are income from self-employment. Since you received this form, rather than Form W-2, the payer may have considered you self-employed and did not withhold social security or Medicare taxes. Report self-employment income on Schedule C, C-EZ, or F (Form 1040), and compute the self-employment tax on Schedule SE (Form 1040). However, if you are not

self-employed, report this amount on Form 1040 on the line for "Wages, salaries, tips, etc." Call the IRS for information about how to report any social security and Medicare taxes.

Box 8—Report as "Other Income" on your tax return. The amount shown is substitute payments in lieu of dividends or tax-exempt interest received by your broker on your behalf after transfer of your securities for use in a short sale.

Box 9—An entry in the checkbox means sales to you of consumer products on a buy-sell, deposit-commission, or any other basis for resale have amounted to \$5,000 or more. The person filing this return does not have to show a dollar amount in this box. Any income from your sale of these products should generally be reported on Schedule C or C-EZ (Form 1040).

Box 10—Report on the line for "Crop insurance proceeds" on Schedule F (Form 1040).

Box 13—If "EPP" is shown, this is excess golden parachute payments subject to a 20% excise tax. See your Form 1040 instructions for the "Total Tax" line. The amount in box 7 is your total compensation.

Amounts shown on this form may be subject to self-employment tax computed on Schedule SE (Form 1040). See Pub. 533, Self-employment Tax, for information on self-employment income. If no income or social security and Medicare taxes were withheld by the payer, you may have to make estimated tax payments if you are still receiving these payments. Dear Interest Owner:

Apache Corporation recently acquired Hadson Energy Resources Corporation (HERC) and HERC is now a wholly owned Apache subsidiary. Apache is presently integrating all HERC records into the Apache computer system and, beginning in January, 1994, Apache will be responsible for the processing and mailing of all revenue payments due in connection with your ownership interest in any HERC property.

As part of this transition from the HERC system onto the Apache computer system, the HERC revenue check you received in December, 1993, represented proceeds which would have normally been mailed to you in January, 1994. Due to this early payment, your next revenue check will not be mailed until February 28, 1994. Thereafter, you can expect to receive your revenue payments monthly as usual. This adjustment is only a timing delay and will not reduce the total revenues which you will ultimately receive.

The first check you receive from Apache will have a new owner number assigned to you and also a new property (well) number. Please make note of these new numbers and include these numbers in all inquiries you make regarding your interest. We have included with this letter Apache Corporation's Remittance Advice Guide for Oil and Gas Interests. Please take time to read this brochure to become familiar with your new owner number, property number and other pertinent information concerning your royalty payments.
